


Wutai Rukai Museum (824m) (Tour de Taiwan)





Wutai is a mountain village, located in the southern part of the island, between two higher than 3000m mounts. Il lies at 800m asl. The stage stops there, but following the (dead-end) main road, we can climb up to 1100m.





Length: 7,5km

Elevation gain : 570m (824-254m) > average 7,6%

Km %: 9,6 9,1 5,3 6,3 7,9 6,2 7,1 10 / 400m + last 100m at 15%






Scenic road

In Wutai, the route turns sharply to the right in an unexpected alley at 15%, that leads to the ethnologic museum, devoted to the Rukai indigenous peoples.
