Topography of Eritrea

Three very clear topographical zones, from north to south. In the east, the seashore along the Red Sea. In the centre, a mountain range (highest point: Emba Soira at 3018m). In the west, a plateau at more than 1000m asl.

A first aborted attempt in 1946, at the time of the Italian colonization (Giro dell'Eritrea); a continuous existence since 2001, except a bracket in 2014 and 2015. The winner list is mostly national. Van Rensburg (South Africa, 2012) is the exception to the rule. Only one Erythrean known at international level: Berhane (2010).




Is bicycle popular in Eritrea?


6th edition since the integration of the race in the UCI calendar (Africa Tour)

5th stage: Massawa-Asmara (113km)

The profile of the stage is basic. Start in Massawa, at Red Sea level; 40km of flat and slighty uphill roads (300m elevation gain); 70km and 2000m in the central mountain range in 3 stages (3 KOM).






