






Abu Dhabi

Abu Dhabi is one of the United Arab Emirates, as well as Dubai and the less known Ajman, Fujairah, Ras al-Khaimah, Sharjah and Umm al Quwain. As shown in pink on the map below, it is the largest by area (80%).



Mountains (Jebel Hafeet) can only be found in a very small region near Al Ain, at the border with the Sultanate of Oman.

Climbers will prefer Ras el Khaimah, thanks to its topographic wealth. In particular, the Jabal al-Jais Mountain Road (1700m) and its numerous hairpins in a desert landscape.

The race is new (3rd edition in 2017), but it already belongs to the UCI World Tour. Its winner list shows its great value and confirms the globalization of pro cycling :








In 2017, the Jebel Hafeet was the finish of the 3rd stage :
